WORKSHOP: Mission's Workshop

MONTH: October 2018

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 6:5-15

THEME: The Lord's Prayer

FOCUS: Teach Us How to Pray

SCRIPTURE MEMORY:

Matthew 6:9-13

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.

ACTIVITY:

I. Bible Lesson: Explain and discuss the Lord's Prayer, line by line. Emphasize the importance of communicating with God, just as we do with our friends and family. We are to praise God for who He is, thank him for our blessings, ask Him to meet our needs, and pray for others.

Tie the lesson to missions by reviewing the unreached T.H.U.M.B. people (Tribals, Hindus, Unreligious, Muslims, and Buddhists). Explain that all people in the world need to hear about Jesus. We can pray for others who don't know about Jesus, for missionaries to bring the Gospel to them, and for their physical and spiritual needs to be met.

- 2. Mission Activity: Children make the Unreached Children Prayer Wheel to take home.
- 3. Prayer Activity: Use the prayer wheel to pray for unreached people groups around the world.

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Card stock, brads, and patterns to make prayer wheel with pictures of unreached children (Tribal, Hindu, Chinese, Buddhist, Muslim, and Other).
